





This project is a public and cultural facility featuring community and exhibition spaces as well as the City of Parramatta's Council Chamber. A place where locals and visitors can meet, discover, learn and share. Its triangular outline is shaped according to the course of the sun, to allow the sun to shine on the square all year round. The roof curves slightly toward the top of the new civic spire, with colors moving from dark to light. The envelope is a highly sustainable skin that filters light and views, creating a poetic atmosphere for the exterior and interior of the project. Inside this chiseled volume, a cascade of levels faces the square in a kind of giant amphitheater. The higher one climbs, the more narrow and intimate the spaces become.


